## INCOMING EXCHANGE STUDENTS

### Application procedure

#### 1. Nomination

As an international student, the person in charge of international relations in your institution has to inform Cécile Thuillier of your nomination by filling in this [form](#).

**Deadline:** 1<sup>st</sup> semester: 20 April  
2<sup>nd</sup> semester: 20 October

#### 2. Application

**Deadline:** 1<sup>st</sup> semester: 30 April  
2<sup>nd</sup> semester: 31 October

#### 3. Selection

Admission to ESA Saint-Luc Bruxelles is validated by the department coordinator and the international office after the examination of application file and depending on available places. A note of acceptance will be sent to the student by email within 5 weeks after the application deadline at the latest.

We organize a welcome week a few days before the start of each semester: the dates of this welcome week will be indicated on your acceptance letter.

#### Semester dates:

1<sup>st</sup> semester: 15 September – 23 January

2<sup>nd</sup> semester: 2 February - 26 June

### Language

**All courses are taught in French at ESA Saint-Luc**

**Bruxelles:** even if some teachers are able to communicate in English, it is in the interest of the student to have a sufficient knowledge of French (B2 recommended) before the mobility in order to follow the courses in the best possible conditions.

Non French-speaking students have access to a free French class (10 hours per semester, 2 ECTS)

### Fees

Students accepted as part of an exchange programme are not required to pay registration fees at ESA Saint-Luc Bruxelles.

### Insurance

Every student living in Belgium needs to be health insured. If you come from a European country, you must ask for your European health insurance card in your home country.

For non-EU students you must ask your insurance company at home if it insures you abroad.

### Visa

EU students do not need a visa.

Non-EU students need one. They should contact the sending and receiving institutions if they need support.
